

How can you implement PBIS in your school?

5 Components of Effective PBIS Practice

● **Define** behavior expectations

- ✓ Decide on your school-wide expectations. Fill in the chart.
 - (general/core values/school needs)
- ✓ What do they look like in your classroom and the school common areas? Fill in the chart on the back.

● **Teach** behavior expectations

- ✓ Create lesson plans for teaching the expected behavior. Be explicit!
- ✓ Visit the natural context.
- ✓ Create visuals.

● **Remind** Daily by using encouragement and Reward Tickets

- ✓ Reteach, remind, reward....daily!
- ✓ What is your Reward System? Consequence System?

● **Celebrate** the desired behaviors

- ✓ Be consistent

● **Correct** the problem behaviors

Tip: Develop an Attention Signal...teach it and use it.
